Then, we will experience a Bahá'í worship service with accomplished choir director of the Bahá'í House of Worship, Van Gilmer. We will conclude the visit with a video presentation on the Bahá'í Faith.

For address and parking information please visit <http://www.bahai.us/bahai-temple/>. The designated parking area is on Sheridan Road with the temple across the street. Walk south on Sheridan by turning left out of the parking lot. After about 200 yards cross Sheridan and walk down Linden Street with the temple on your right. Pass the main entrance to the temple and enter the construction site, about 40 yards past the main entrance. You can then enter the new Welcome Center through the front door. We will convene inside the new building to start our tour. Note: please allow one hour and fifteen minutes from north Naperville to get to Wilmette. The tour will begin promptly at 2:00 pm.
